HISTORY AND TRADITIONS

Avadh Girls' Degree College is an Institution for Higher Education of Women, run by the Avadh Educational Society. Founded in 1958 as Loreto Degree College, it was taken over by the Avadh Educational Society in 1975 from Loreto Convent. In 1975-76 the Degree College was handed over in totality by the Government to Avadh Educational Society with Begum Hamida Habibullah as President, Late (Mrs.) Kamla Bhargava as Manager and Late (Mrs.) B.C. Sharma as its Principal. Under her Principalship the Institution, with its new name, continued its march with eleven faculty members, one librarian, one office staff and four fourth class employees. With the concerted efforts of an excellent and dedicated staff, the College steered through the changeover smoothly. Today, it is a leading Institution, having imparted value based education to innumerable students for over six decades.

The College inculcates and encourages academic and extra academic excellence in its students. Thousands of students have passed through its portals, equipped to successfully take their place in society. It is a matter of great pride that many of them have carved out a niche for themselves in a wide variety of areas, specially the Indian Administrative and Allied Services, Banking, C.A., C.S., Defence and other top Managerial positions.

The College has certain traditions and all students are expected to observe them. The College lays equal emphasis on curricular and extra-curricular activities. The Dean of Studies and the Dean of Students co-ordinate and take care of the academic and extra academic activities of the students. The Deans also provide a liaison between the Principal, Staff and Students, President, Vice-President (B.A. / B.Com. III), Presidents of the ten extra-curricular activity clubs, N.S.S. and Representatives and Secretaries of B.A. / B.Com I, II & III.

Each student is a member of three compulsory Clubs: Social-Service, Sports and Entertainment. Besides these, she is expected to join at least one other Club. Enrolment to these Clubs must be completed within the stipulated period.

Various cultural functions are organized by the various Clubs under the supervision of a Faculty Advisor during the session and the students are given ample opportunity to develop and display their talents.

At the beginning of the session, the College commences its session with an Orientation Programme. In this the students are familiarized with the College Campus, the Library, the Staff and the Traditions of the College.

The Investiture Ceremony marks the beginning of the official functioning of the Council of Students. The Council then organises a Social to welcome the freshers to create a feeling of fraternity amongst them.

The College recognizes and rewards the achievements of the students in the academic and extra-academic fields at the Annual Awards Day held towards the close of the session. Regular attendance in classes is essential for the students to be considered for the awards. The Valedictory Assembly marks the end of the session.

DISCIPLINE

Great emphasis is laid on discipline as it is an integral part of the overall personality development of a student. The students are required to abide by the rules and regulations of the College and maintain a high level of discipline.

ATTENDANCE: As per College rules, every student must attend classes regularly. A minimum of 75 per cent of attendance (As per University Rules) is required in each subject. **Certificates and letters of references for various competitive exams and courses e.g. CAT, MAT etc. will be issued only to those students who have the required percentage of attendance.** Every student must ensure her enrolment in the respective subjects cleared by the Admission Committee at the time of Admission. Students must attend all classes from the commencement of the academic session. In case absence is due to illness, the student must submit an application signed by the parent / guardian along with a certificate from a registered Medical Practitioner.

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The College encourages students to pursue various professional courses / jobs along with their regular classes provided such courses / jobs do not interfere with their College class timings.

- **UNIFORM:** Students are expected to be decently dressed on all College Days. The College has a 'uniform' for formal occasions only. All students must order this prescribed uniform in the College at the time of admission and collect it on time. The College will not be responsible if the students fail to collect their uniforms. (In case of any problem pertaining to it the student must meet the Principal). Students participating in sports or representing the College in the Inter-Collegiate, Inter-State or other sports activities must wear the prescribed sports uniform.

- It is compulsory to wear the College Uniform on all formal occasions and Semester Examinations.

- **Campus Cleanliness:** Students must keep the campus clean. The College has a lush green garden with various plants and trees. It is mandatory for the students to help in keeping their surroundings clean and green.

- The College has designated Canteen area, with ample seating places. The students should note at in the classrooms.

NB: Disciplinary action will be taken against students found indulging in littering the campus and classrooms. Wearing the helmet is compulsory, failing which a fine of ₹500/- (Rupees Five Hundred) shall be imposed.

- **PARKING OF VEHICLES:** The College maintains a parking system for students desirous of using it for their two wheelers. Vehicles **MUST NOT** be parked at the college entrance or in the drive way. Special provisions are made for differently abled students.

- Annual parking fee ₹ 700/- (Rupees Seven Hundred) is charged for two wheelers only. The student must collect her receipt and Parking Card from the College office. This card must be shown whenever asked by the concerned authority.

DOCUMENTS & CARDS: Every student of the College must have an Identity Card and a Parking Card (For students coming by two wheelers), issued by the College. She must always wear the Identity Card on person while on campus. These cards must be complete in all respects and the fee column must have the entry by the authorized office staff. Students carrying identity Cards showing blank or incomplete fee-columns will not be allowed to appear in the Semester Examinations. The students must, therefore, ensure that their parking cards are updated on time. Students are not allowed entry in to the accounts' offices. All work pertaining to official matters is to be done through the Coordinator. Disobedience in this regard is treated as gross indiscipline. Tampering with one's Identity Card or forging of signatures is a serious offence, liable to strict disciplinary action. These cards must be produced at the time of the Semester Examinations by every candidate.



- All the students are advised to collect a receipt against any payment made by them in the College at any time.

NOTICES: Students must read regularly all the notice updates on the notice-boards of the College and on the college website, 'www.agdc.ac.in' and official Facebook Page. The College will not accept any responsibility for any loss or damage incurred by a student owing to her failure to read the notices in time either in the College or on the College website.

ALL STUDENTS MUST

- a) Deposit fees and collect their receipts on time. **Fee Receipts are important.**
- b) Collect their Identity Cards within the notified period to avoid fine /penalty.
- **FINES AND PENALTIES:** The students are liable to be fined incase of:
 - (1) Loss of Fee Receipts, Identity-Cards and Parking Cards: ₹50/- (Rupees Fifty)
 - (2) Semester Examination Form (Late Fees as per the University of Lucknow).
- **Students found indulging in indiscipline, violating College RULES or resorting to unfair means in the Semester Examinations** will be liable to strict disciplinary action. The students are required to show due regard for the rights and property of the College. Any student found guilty of tampering or damaging the property, fixtures, equipment, furniture, books, building, vehicles etc. of the College will be punished and be liable for expulsion from the College.
- A student is required to make a declaration to the effect that she will submit to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the College and will observe and abide by the rules made by the College. **In matters of interpretation of the rules and the jurisdiction of the authorities of the College** the student will have to accept the decision of the **Principal as final and binding.**
- **RAGGING:** Ragging in any form is totally banned in the College. The College has an Anti-Ragging Cell. Any student found guilty of indulging in ragging of any kind will be expelled from the College and subject to action as per Government directives.
- The College maintains a **Mentor Mentee System** under which each student is allotted a Faculty Mentor to resolve any problem of the students. Students having any problems, queries or requiring assistance must approach these Mentors or Deans for help or guidance. Students still not satisfied with the Redressal may then approach the Principal on stipulated days and time. They will have to seek prior appointment from the Principal's Office to avoid any inconvenience incase their parents / guardian wish to meet the Principal.

NB: Mentor Mentee Meeting shall be held on 04th Tuesday in the month of August.

COURSES OF STUDY

The students are prepared for the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.), Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.) and Masters Degree in English (M.A.) University of Lucknow. **The medium of instruction is English.**

• **B.A. (BACHELOR OF ARTS):** B.A. (NEP) Four Year Programme from the session 2022-2023. The student will choose two major subjects (Major & Major 2) and one Minor subject from the ten subjects available in the College, from the permitted combinations of subjects for B.A. – Semester-1 students. Each student is responsible for the subject combination chosen by her endorsed by the Admission Committee. Each student will have to take her University Examination in the subjects finally allotted to her.

B.COM. (BACHELOR OF COMMERCE): The B.Com., classes, ever since its inception in 2001 at Avadh Girls' Degree College, has shown meteoric rise in term of influx of students so much so that another section was introduced in the next year. The reasons are not far-fetched to seek but for excellent results at the University Examination, culmination of good teaching by adequate qualified staff besides ambient atmosphere due to teacher taught interaction. Further, in order to enhance mental horizon in terms of commerce education and what holds for them in future. The interaction is made out with eminent people as and when feasible. The stress on extra curricular activities is for the sake of personality development and vision. The future for Commerce Education is bright due to rapid increase in Industrialisation Trade and Commerce. This has led to an increase in demand for professionals, our College gives a platform to their further studies, making it the most sought-after College for Women's Commerce Education.

THE COURSE IS AS PER THE N.E.P. GUIDELINES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF LUCKNOW

M.A. (English): The College offers an M.A. Programme in English with a maximum enrolment of 60 students.

The eligibility criteria for Admission to the Course is as follows:

Graduation from a Recognised University with Marks as per the following rules:

- a) If the candidate has studied English in all the three years of graduation, the eligibility will be minimum 45% of marks.



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b) If the candidate has studied English in first two years of graduation, but not in the final year the eligibility will be minimum 55% of marks.

d) If the Candidate has not studied English in any year of the graduation, eligibility will be minimum 60% of marks.

ATTENDANCE: Students are required to have 75 percent attendance (as specified by the University of Lucknow) during the session. Final Examination Forms will only be forwarded of those students who fulfill the above criterion of 75 percent attendance. Parents must ensure that their wards have the requisite attendance. Students having short attendance in any subject will not be permitted to appear for Semester Examinations.

Scholarship: Financial aid by way of fee / books is given by the College to meritorious students of B.A. and B.Com. from economically weaker section. This facility can be availed through an application submitted to the Co-Ordinator's Office by the end of August. There is also a provision of Welfare Scholarship for SC, ST, OBC, General and Minority students. **75% attendance is compulsory to get any Scholarship (as per Government Rules).**

 - Dr. Upma Chaturvedi (Ex-Principal, Avadh Girls' Degree College, Lucknow) took the initiative to celebrate the Golden Jubilee of 1969 batch in month of February 2019.
 - During the Pandemic the Alumnae Association got an opportunity to do charity and reach out the needy people.
 - Alumnae Association has completed its two term (10 years).
 - The third term will begin from May 2022.
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LIBRARY

The College has a well equipped Digitalised Library to promote Scholarship and learning amongst its students. The Library offers the facility of INFLIBNET and DELNET to the staff and students, which gives access to more than 92,27,613 books; 33,916 periodicals; 9,12,342 Periodicals Articles; 19,234 CD Rom; 5000 Video Recordings; 48,621 Dissertations; 1,631 e-books, besides providing Infrastructure for sharing of Library resources among Academic and Research Institutes of World Repute. The Library has an open-shelf system.

A Library Orientation Programme is organized for the First year Students at the beginning of each new session in which they are acquainted with the Catalogue System, the Reference Books Section, the Book-Bank and the System of Issuing and Returning of Books. The students are required to use the Catalogue System for locating and issuing the requisite books. Students must have their identity card and library card for issuing of books. Books are issued for only six days at a time. A fine of ₹ 5/- per day is charged on books over due. All books and magazines must be handled with care. If a book is subjected to any damage or pages are found missing, the borrower will be held responsible and will have to replace the book. The students are, therefore, advised to check the books before borrowing them and if they discover any kind of damage, it must be immediately reported to the Librarian. If a book is lost, the borrower will have to replace it with the same edition / revised edition / or pay the current price of the Book.

Book Bank: The College Library maintains a Book Bank and deserving students may borrow books from it through membership. Priority for membership will be given to students of Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes, S.T. and Minorities and those whose parents' income is not more than ₹1.5 Lakh per year.

- i. Each member of the Book Bank is entitled to borrow six books at a time.
 - ii. Student eligible for membership to the Book Bank is required to submit an application in duplicate with the necessary documents at the time of admission.
 - iii. Books can be issued for the full academic session.
 - iv. Security deposit of ₹110/- and 10% of the price of the book will be taken at the time of issuing of books which shall be refunded on return of books in good condition.
- a) If a book is subject to any damage or if any pages are found missing, the borrower will be held responsible and will have to replace the book. The students are advised to check the books before borrowing them and if they discover any kind of damage; it must immediately be reported to the Librarian. If a book is lost, the borrower will have to replace it with the same edition / revised edition / pay a fine which is three times the cost of the book.
 - b) It is at the discretion of the Librarian / Principal to take action against the student for misusing the Library or breaking the rules.

Note: Any change in the rules will be notified.

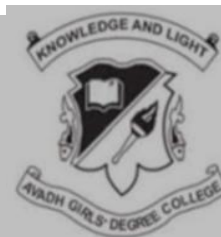
COMPUTER LAB:

The college has a fully equipped, air-conditioned computer laboratory with power back-up consisting of 37 computers (...) with Intel (R) Core™ i5 – 6500 CPU @ 3.20 Ghz processor, 4 GB RAM, 64 bit Windows 10 Home Single Language.

The laboratory is wifi- enabled with 300 MBPS fibreband connection. The laboratory is also equipped with one printer (HP Laserjet Pro M203dn) and one printer cum scanner (HP Laserjet M1005 MFP).

The laboratory regularly updates the hardware, software and networking as per requirements. Students can get hands-on experience on latest software applications and browse permitted internet sites for academic purposes.

The college also gives an opportunity to the students to avail Certificate Course free of cost. The certificate course includes “ Fundamental Training in Computers, MS-Office, Photoshop and CorelDraw.



CLUBS / N.S.S. / N.C.C.

- There are 10 clubs, N.S.S. and N.C.C. in the College which function under the supervision of the respective Club Advisors and hold events throughout the year.
- The Clubs also conduct Workshops and hold Competitions in the designated respective fields for the holistic development of the students.

Compulsory Clubs:

1. **ENTERTAINMENT CLUB:** Its aim is to train the Students in organizing and managing Events. The Club is responsible for the hospitality at various College functions.
2. **SOCIAL SERVICE CLUB:** The prime objective of this Club is to Inculcate a sense of service towards the Society, especially the under-privileged section. It also looks after the welfare of the class-IV employees and their families also.
3. **SPORTS CLUB:** The objective of the Sports Club is to enhance the physical development of students and inculcate team spirit and healthy competition. Students get ample opportunity for various indoor and outdoor games including athletic activities.

4. **DEBATING CLUB:** Its aim is to develop the students' potential in the art of public speaking and debating.
5. **DRAMATICS CLUB:** This club aims at developing the histrionic Potential of the students and organizes several dramatic activities and competitions.
6. **ECO-RESTORATION CLUB:** This Club aims at inculcating environment awareness amongst the students and works towards restoring the ecological balance.
7. **FINE ARTS CLUB:** This Club aims at inculcating and displaying the artistic skills of the students and organizes activities like painting, poster making and collage competitions etc., throughout the year, encouraging and showcasing the aesthetic taste.
8. **LITERARY CLUB:** This club aims at encouraging the literary talents of the students and organizes elocution, general knowledge quiz, essay writing and creative writing activities. It also publishes the Annual College Magazine "The Avadhite".
9. **MUSIC CLUB:** It organizes music and dance events and competitions throughout the year.



10. PHOTOGRAPHY AND GRAPHIC DESIGN CLUB: The aim of this club is to inculcate creativity among students in Photography and Graphic Designing. The Club organizes competitions of still photography, documentary, short films etc.

11. NATIONAL service scheme (N.S.S.) (Under the aegis of M.H.R.D) – The aim of N.S.S. is the personality development of the students by Voluntary Selfless Service to the society. There are three N.S.S. Units in the College. Membership is voluntary. Members of this Scheme who attend the Annual N.S.S. Camp are awarded Certificates. Percentage weightage in admission to courses like B.Ed., etc. is given to students who have been enrolled in N.S.S. for two years and attended one year Annual N.S.S. Camp.

12. National Cadet Corps (N.C.C.): The National Cadet Corps (N.C.C.) provides opportunities to the youth for all round development with a sense of duty, commitment, dedication, discipline and moral values so that they may become able leaders and useful citizens. The N.C.C. provides exposure to the cadets in a wide range of activities, with a distinct emphasis on social service, discipline and adventure training. The N.C.C. is open to all regular students of the College on a voluntary basis. There are only 100 seats which shall be allotted on a first come first serve basis.

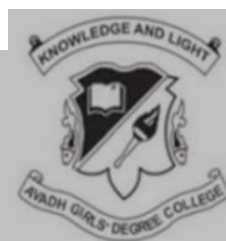
- The College has N.C.C. under 19 U.P. Girls' BN Lucknow.

College A/C”**. Students must write their own name, their father’s / mother’s name and class, t the back of the draft being deposited by them. Fee once paid is neither refundable nor transferable. Students are advised to preserve all fee receipts which are required for obtaining the Examination Form, Admit Card and Confirmation of payment of fees. There must not be any tampering on the fee receipt. Any change must be intimated to the Principal or the Office.

Only fee paid as Caution Money by the student at the time of admission is refundable. Fee payment does not entitle any student the right to appear at the Semester Examination. Late applications will not be considered. They must, therefore, obtain their No-Dues Certificates from their Departments / Library / Office / before the stipulated period. If the refund is not claimed within the stipulated time, the students will forfeit all claims for this refund after three years.
