Rules for the events

FOXTROT - THE DANCE COMPETITION

1) DANCING- SOLO DANCE (FUSION)

- Only 1 entry per college or an institution is allowed.
- Time limit- Minimum 2 minutes, Maximum 4 minutes.
- Usage of props is allowed
- **Participants must bring their songs in the CD form and also they have to submit their songs in Pen Drive, 2 days before the competition.**
- Only **FUSION** dance form is allowed.
- Not following the time limit will lead to negative marking.
- Last minute changes in the above rules if necessary can be made.

- Props Usage
- Facial Expressions
- Costumes
- Overall Presentation

2. GROUP DANCE

- There will be only 1 team from a college or an institution.
- Time Limit- Minimum 4, Maximum 5 minutes.
- Usage of props is allowed.
- Team size- 4 to 8 members.
- **Participants must bring their songs in the CD form and also they have to submit their songs in Pen Drive, 2 days before the competition.**
- Themes of dance are **Lights, Camera and Action And Taal se Taal Mila.**
- All the dance forms are allowed.
- Not following the time limit will lead to negative marking.

- Props usage.
- Synchronization and formation.
- Costumes.
- Innovation and facial expressions.

- Overall presentation
- Last minute changes in the above rules, if necessary, can be made by the judges.

RHYTHM DIVINE – THE SINGING COMPETITION

2. SINGING DUET

- Only 1 team is allowed from a college or an institution.
- Time limit- Minimum 2minutes, Maximum 4 minutes
- No instruments are allowed except karaoke (music).
- Judges decision will be final and binding.
- Not following the time limit will lead to negative marking.
- Last minute changes in the above rules, if necessary, can be made by the judges.

JUDGEMENT CRITERIA

- On the basis of selection of songs
- Co-ordination
- Voice quality
- Overall presentation

CANVAS – THE ART EVENTS

1. RANGOLI MAKING

- 1 team per college or an institution.
- 3 participants per team from a college or an institution.
- Use of food grains and flowers would lead to disqualification.
- Time limit- 45 minutes.
- Theme will be given on the spot.
- Bring your own material.
- Judges decision is final and binding.
- Last minute changes in the above rules, if necessary, can be made by the judges.

- Neatness
- Creativity
- Color Scheme

2. FACE PAINTING:

RULES :

- One team per College
- Two participants
- Time Limit – 45 minutes
- Theme will be given on the spot.
- Bring your own materials i.e. Brushes and Paints etc.
- Judges' decision will be final and binding.
- Last minute changes in the above rules, if necessary , can be made by the judges.

- Creativity

COLLAGE MAKING

- Number of teams per college: minimum 1 and maximum 2.
- Number of participants per team is minimum 1 and maximum 2.
- Time limit – 45 minutes+ 15 minutes (judging)
- Only a chart paper would be provided to the participants.
- Theme for the event is “**Phenomenal Woman**”.
- No use of scissors.
- Last minute changes in the above rules if necessary can be made by judge/judges.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- Any team which does not follow the above rules will be disqualified.

- Relevance to the theme

3. T-SHIRT PAINTING

- Number of teams per college : 2 maximum
- Number of participants is Minimum 1 and maximum 2.
- T-Shirt has to be painted on the spot
- Time limit- 45 minutes+15 minutes (judging).
- Participants have to get their own material
- Materials to be used –
 - a) Plain T-Shirt (any color)
 - b) Any material as per requirements.
- Theme will be given on the spot.

- Last minute changes in the above rules if necessary can be made by judge/judges.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- Any team which does not follow the above rules will be disqualified.

4. BEST OUT OF WASTE

- 2 Participants per team from a college or an institute.
- Maximum 2 teams from a college or an institute.
- Maximum use of waste materials
- Time limit – 1 hour
- No materials will be provided.
- The recycled products should be useful.
- Last minute changes in the above rules if necessary can be made.
- Judges decision is final and binding.

JUDGEMENT CRITERIA

- Use of waste materials
- Creativity
- Usage after recycling

POSTER MAKING

- Minimum 1 and maximum 3 teams per college or an institute.
- Minimum 1 and maximum 2 participants per team.
- Half a chart paper must be used.
- Color (Any sort).
- No cutting and pasting.
- Give a slogan to the poster.
- Border should be made.
- Materials to be arranged by the participants.
- College will not provide any type of material.

NUKKAD NATAK **RULES:**

- 1 team per college or an institute

- Maximum number of participants in a team will be 10 and minimum 4.
- Use of Hindi and English allowed.
- Maximum performance time is 15 minutes but not less than 5 minutes.
- Teams must adhere to dress code which is a white shirt/ T-shirt/ Kurta and jeans or white kurta salwar.
- The theme of the Nukkad Natak is “**Challenges for the Mentally Challenged Individuals**”.
- Last minute changes in the above rules can be made, if necessary, by the judge/ judges.
- The decision of the judge/judges shall be final and binding.
- No Props are allowed except ‘Dhapli’. (Negative marking for use of props).

SKIT

- Maximum number of participants in a team is 7 and minimum 3.
- Each college or an institute can send a maximum of one team.
- Use of only Hindi and English is allowed.
- Time limit- 10 minutes. (5 minutes extra for stage setting/ removal of props).
- No use of slang or otherwise offensive language is allowed. Negative marking will be done or the participants will be disqualified.
- Each team should get their own props.
- Last minute changes in the above rules can be made by the judge/judges if necessary.
- Judges decision will be final and binding.

- Acting

- Costumes and make-up

AD- MAD

- 1 team from a college or an institute
- Number of participants should be minimum 4 and maximum 5.
- Use of only Hindi and English is allowed.
- Product for the first round will be given before hand and will be same for all teams. Time limit for the first round is 3 minutes for each team.
- The product for the second round will be given on the spot. 10 minutes will be allotted for preparing and 3 minutes for performing.
- Both the advertisements should have a jingle (tag/ punch line).

- Originality of idea
- Jingle (tag/ punch line)
- Presentation
- Dialogue Delivery

BRAINSTORM: THE QUIZ COMPETION

RULES:

- Only 1 entry per college or an institution is allowed.
- Each team will have 2 participants.
- All the teams will have to answer within the given time limit, i.e.; 40 seconds and every passed answer will have to be answered in 10 seconds.
- No refutation will be entertained.
- In case of a tie between two or more teams, a tie breaking question will be asked and the team which gives the correct answer first, will be declared as the winner.
- Last minute changes in the above rules if necessary can be made.
- Quizmaster's decision shall be final and binding.

RAVISHING RENDITIONS: THE ELOCUTION COMPETITION

RULES

- Minimum 1 and maximum 2 participants from the college or an institution.
- Medium – English/Hindi.
- Time limit- 3 minutes.
- Negative marking that is -1 on exceeding the time limit i.e. 2 minutes.
- The participants are requested to bring 3 copies of their elocution matter.
- Reading or consulting a hard copy shall amount to a disqualification.

DIALECTIC BRAINS: THE DEBATE COMPETITION

TOPIC : “ In the era of Globalization Women Empowerment is a myth ”

RULES :

- Maximum 1 team can participate from each college/university.
- Each team will consist of 2 participants (1 ‘for’ the motion and ‘against’ the motion).
- Use of both Hindi and English medium is permissible but the participants shall stick to only one medium (i.e. either Hindi or English).
- The time limits is 3+1 mins.
- A warning bell will be rung after 2 min. 30seconds, after which the participants are expected to conclude their speech.
- Any use of slang or offensive language shall not be acceptable.
- Occasional references to any written matter are permissible, but direct looking into the paper will lead to negative marking.
- REFUTATION will be allowed only for 1 minute.
- No cross questioning will be allowed during refutation.
- Any participant receiving no refutation will get full 10 marks.

- The participants will not be marked on the basis of questions they ask, but on how they answer.

DELIBERATE DIPLOMATS:

THE TURNCOAT COMPETITION

RULES:

- Two participants per college/university/institution are allowed.
- The participants shall get on the topic (the topics shall be pertaining to general issues).
- The rule applied will be 2+1+1; i.e. the participant will get 2 minutes thinking time, and then shall speak 1 minute for the motion and 1 minute against the motion on the same topic.
- Use of both Hindi and English medium is permissible but the participant shall stick to one medium only (i.e. either Hindi or English)
- A bell will be rung after 1 minute after which the participants are expected to speak against the motion.
- Any use of slang or offensive language shall not be acceptable.
- No participants will be allowed to exceed the time limit.
