# Rules for the events

# 1. <u>Angakshari</u>

- Only 1 team per college is allowed.
- There will be total 4 rounds.
- Maximum 3 members in a team.

#### ROUND 1

- The first team will be given a letter with which they have to sing a song. All the other teams will have to follow the general rules of the antakshari i.e. to sing a song with the letter with which the previous team ended.
- Time limit 10 seconds to think, failing which, the turn will be passed on to the next team.
- Teams must have to sing the entire mukhda of the song. NOTE- Marks will be deducted on singing the wrong song.

#### ROUND 2

- This is an audio/video round.
- An audio/video will be played for all the teams one after another, in which a song is only enacted but the lyrics will of another song. Teams will have to identify the enacted song and sing it.
- Time limit-15 seconds to think, failing to which, the turn will be passed on to the next team.

NOTE- Marks will be deducted on singing the wrong song.

#### ROUND 3

- In this round, a word will be given to all the teams and they have to sing a song in which that given letter comes.
- Time limit- 10 seconds to think, failing to which, the turn will be passed on to the next team.

#### NOTE- Marks will be deducted on singing the wrong song.

#### ROUND 4

- This is the bollywood quiz round in which an audio clip will be played for all the teams one after another, and a question will be put up related to that song or audio. Teams will have to answer the questions.
- Time limit-15 seconds to think, failing to which, the turn will be passed on to the next team.

NOTE- Marks will be deducted on singing the wrong song. No elimination will take place in any round. Team scoring the highest score will be declared winner.

### 2. <u>SINGING DUEG</u>

- Only 1 team is allowed from a college or an institution.
- Time limit- Minimum 2minutes, Maximum 4 minutes
- No instruments is allowed except karaoke
- Judges decision will be final and binding
- Last minute changes in the above rules, if necessary, can be made by the judges.

### 3. <u>Dancing- Solo Dance</u>

- Only 1 entry per college or an institution is allowed.
- Time limit- Minimum 2 minutes, Maximum 4 minutes.

- Participants must bring their songs in the CD form and also they have to submit their songs in Pen Drive, 2 days before the competition.
- All the dance forms are allowed.

### 4. <u>Group Dance</u>

- There will be only 1 team from a college or an institution.
- Time Limit- Minimum 6 minutes, Maximum 8 minutes.
- Usage of props is allowed.
- Team size- 4 to 8 members.

- Participants must bring their songs in the CD form and also they have to submit their songs in Pen Drive, 2 days before the competition
- All the dance forms are allowed.

- Props usage.
- Synchronization and formation.
- Costumes.
- Innovation and facial expressions.
- Overall presentation
- Last minute changes in the above rules, if necessary, can be made by the judges.

# 5. <u>Rangoli making</u>

- 2 participants per team from a college or an institution.
- Use of grains and flowers would lead to disqualification.
- Time limit- 45 minutes.
- Theme will be given on the spot.
- Bring your own material.
- Judges decision is final and binding.
- Last minute changes in the above rules, if necessary, can be made by the judges.

# 6. <u>Tattoo making</u>

- 2 participants per team from a college or an institution.
- Time limit- 45 minutes.
- Theme will be given on the spot.
- Bring your own material, i.e.; brushes and paints.
- Judges decision will be final and binding.
- Last minute changes in the above rules, if necessary, can be made by the judges.

# 7. <u>Collage making</u>

- Number of teams per college: minimum 1 and maximum 2.
- Number of participants is minimum 1 and maximum 2.
- Time limit 45 minutes+ 15 minutes (judging)
- Only a chart paper would be provided to the participants.
- Theme will be given on the spot.
- No use of scissors.
- Last minute changes in the above rules if necessary can be made by judge/judges.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- Any team which does not follow the above rules will be disqualified.

## 8. <u>T-Shirt Painting</u>

- Number of teams per college : 2 maximum
- Number of participants is Minimum 1 and maximum 2.
- T-Shirt has to be painted on the spot
- Time limit- 45 minutes+15 minutes (judging).
- Participants have to get their own material
- Materials to be used
  - a) Plain T-Shirt (any color)
  - b) Any material as per requirements.
- Theme on the spot will be given
- Last minute changes in the above rules if necessary can be made by judge/judges.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- Any team which does not follow the above rules will be disqualified.

### 9. <u>Slogan Writing</u>

- 2 Participants per team from a college or an institute.
- Maximum 2 teams from a college or an institute.

- Time limit-45 minutes.
- Medium should be English.
- Theme will be given on the spot.
- Slogan should not be of more than one line.
- No materials will be provided.

- Topic Relevance
- Creativity (presentation)
- Originality of thought
- Language

### 10. <u>Best out of waste</u>

- 2 Participants per team from a college or an institute.
- Maximum 2 teams from a college or an institute.
- Maximum use of waste materials
- Time limit 1 hour
- No materials will be provided.
- The recycled products should be useful.
- Last minute changes in the above rules if necessary can be made.
- Judges decision is final and binding.

- Use of waste materials
- Creativity
- Usage after recycling

### 11. <u>Poster making</u>

- Minimum 1 and maximum 3 teams per college or an institute.
- Minimum 1 and maximum 2 participants per team.
- Half a chart paper must be used.
- Color (Any sort).
- No cutting and pasting.
- Give a slogan to the poster.
- Border should be made.
- Materials to be arranged by the participants.
- College will not provide any type of material.

### 12. <u>QUIZ</u>

- Only 1 entry per college or an institution is allowed.
- Each team will have 2 participants.
- All the teams will have to answer within the given time limit, i.e.; 40 seconds and every passed answer will have to be answered in 10 seconds.
- No refutation will be entertained.
- In case of a tie between the two or more teams, a tie breaking questions will be asked and the team which gives the correct answer first, will be declared as the winner.
- Every correct answer will carry 5 marks and every passed answer will carry 2 marks.

### 13. <u>Nukkad nagak</u>

- 1 team per college or an institute
- Maximum number of participants in a team will be 10 and minimum 4.
- Use of Hindi and English allowed.
- Maximum performance time is 15 minutes but not less than 5 minutes.
- Teams must adhere to dress code which is a white shirt/ T-shirt/ Kurta and jeans or white kurta salwar.
- The theme of the Nukkad Natak must be about the current social issue prevalent in our country.
- Last minute changes in the above rules can be made, if necessary, by the judge/ judges.
- The decision of the judge/judges shall be final and binding.
- No Props are allowed except for 'Dhapli' (Negative marking for use of props).

# 14. <u>skig</u>

- Maximum number of participants in a team is 7 and minimum 3.
- Each college or an institute can send a maximum of one team.
- Use of only Hindi and English is allowed.
- Time limit- 10 minutes. (5 minutes extra for stage setting/ removal of props).
- No use of slang or otherwise offensive language is allowed. Negative marking will be done or the participants will be disqualified.
- Each team should get their own props.
- Last minute changes in the above rules can be made by the judge/judges if necessary.
- Judges decision will be final and binding.

# 15. <u>mono – Acting</u>

- Maximum number of participant is 1 from each college or an institute.
- Time limit- 3 minutes minimum and 5 minutes maximum.
- Medium should be either English or Hindi
- No use of slang or offensive language is allowed
- The participant should bring his/her props.

- Negative marking for performing less than 3 minutes or more than 5 minutes.
- Last minute changes in the above rules can be made by the judge/judges.
- Judges decision will be final and binding.

### 16. <u>Ad-mad</u>

- 1 team from a college or an institute
- Number of participants should be minimum 4 and maximum 6.
- Use of only Hindi and English is allowed.
- Product for the first round will be given before hand and will be same for all teams. Time limit for the first round is 3 minutes for each team.
- The product for the second round will be given on the spot. 10 minutes will be allotted for preparing and 3 minutes for performing.
- Both the advertisements should have a jingle (tag/ punch line).

## 17. <u>Elocution</u>

- Minimum 1 and maximum 2 participants from the college or an institution.
- Medium English and Hindi.
- Time limit- 2+ 1 minute.
- Negative marking that is -5 for exceeding the time limit and -5 for reciting less than 2 minutes.
- The participants are requested to bring the matter for elocution along with them (3 copies)
- The participants are not allowed to look into the matter while presenting the poem on the stage.

### 18. <u>Extempore</u>

- 2 participants per college or an institution is allowed.
- Two rounds will be held.
- First round is the picking of chit round and second round is judges' choice.
- 1+2 Rule is applied. The participants shall get 1 minute as thinking time and 2 minutes as speaking time.
- No participants will be allowed to exceed the time limit.
- Stick to the usage of English language only.

# 19. <u>Jam</u>

- 2 participants per college or an institution is allowed.
- Each participant will randomly pick a topic and immediately start speaking on it. There is no thinking time given to the participant.
- The follow participant can 'JAM' the speaker as soon as the speaker makes any error.
- The participants who jam first will point the error and if the moderator finds the error valid, the participant who jams will continue speaking on the same topic.
- The participant would speak only for one minute on the whole on a particular topic.
- The errors on which the participant can be jam are
  - a) Stammering
  - b) Unnecessary pausing
  - c) Repetition of thoughts and sentences
  - d) Grammatical errors
  - e) Deviation from the topic
  - f) Usage of slang or words from other language apart from English.
- The scoring will be as follows:
  - a) +1 for every valid jamming.
  - b) -1 for valid jamming.

- c) +5 for the participants who speaks continuously without being jammed for 30 seconds.
- d) +20 for the participant who speaks continuously for the whole 1 minute without being jammed.
