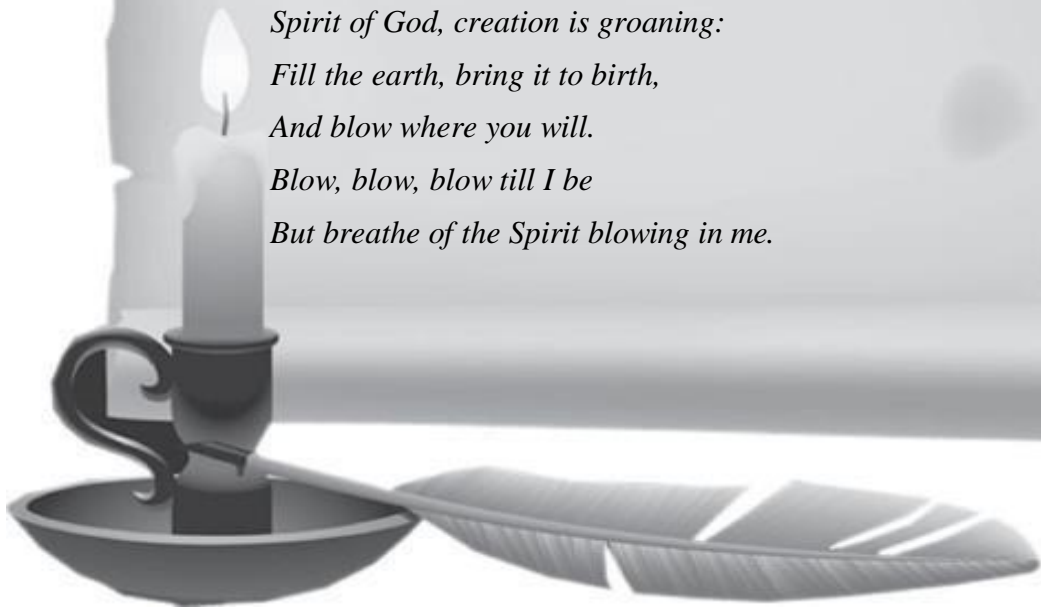

HISTORY AND TRADITION

Avadh Girls' Degree College is an Institution for Higher Education of Women, run by the Avadh Educational Society. Founded in 1958 as Loreto Degree College, it was taken over by the Avadh Educational Society in 1975 from Loreto Convent. In 1975-76 the Degree College was handed over in totality by the Government to Avadh Educational Society with Begum Hamida Habibullah as the President, Late (Mrs.) Kamla Bhargava as the Manager and Late (Mrs.) B.C. Sharma as its Principal. Under her Principalship the Institution, with its new name, continued its march with eleven faculty members, one librarian, one office staff and four fourth class employees. With the concerted efforts of an excellent and dedicated staff, the College steered through the changeover smoothly. Today, it is a leading Institution, having imparted value based education to innumerable students for over six decades.

The College inculcates and encourages academic and extra academic excellence in its students. Thousands of students have passed through its portals, equipped to successfully take their place in society. It is a matter of great pride that many of them have carved out a niche for themselves in a wide variety of areas, specially the Indian Administrative and Allied Services, Banking, C.A., C.S., Defence and other top Managerial positions.

The College has certain traditions and all students are expected to observe them. The College lays equal emphasis on curricular and extra-curricular activities. The Dean of Studies and the Dean of Students co-ordinate and take care of the academic and extra academic activities of the students. The Deans also provide a liaison between the Principal, Faculty and Students, President, Vice-President (B.A. / B.Com. III), Presidents of the ten extra-curricular activity clubs, N.S.S. and Representatives of B.A. / B.Com I, II, III & M.A. I & M.A. II.

Each student is expected to join atleast three Clubs: Entertainment, Social Service, Sports, Debating, Dramatics, Eco-Restoration, Fine Arts, Literary, Music and Photography and Graphic Designing. Enrolment to these Clubs must be completed within the stipulated period.

Several functions are organized by the various Clubs under the supervision of a Faculty Advisor during the session and the students are given ample opportunity to develop and display their talents

The College commences its session with an Orientation Programme. In this the students are familiarized with the College Campus, the Library, the Computer Lab, the Faculty and the Traditions of the College.

The Investiture Ceremony marks the beginning of the official functioning of the Council of Students. The Council then organizes a Social to welcome the freshers to create feeling of fraternity amongst them.

The College recognizes and rewards the achievements of the students in the academic and extra-academic fields at the Annual Awards Day, held towards the close of the session. Regular attendance in classes is essential for the students to be considered for the awards. The Valedictory Assembly marks the end of the session.

DISCIPLINE

Great emphasis is laid on discipline as it is an integral part of the overall personality development of a student. The students are required to abide by the rules and regulations of the College and maintain a high level of discipline.

Attendance: As per University and College rules, every student must attend classes regularly. A minimum of 75% Biometric attendance (as per Government Rules) is required in each subject. **Certificates and letters of references for various competitive exams and course eg. CAT, MAT etc. will be issued only to those students who have the required percentage of attendance.** Every student must ensure her enrolment in the respective subjects cleared by the Admission Committee at the time of Admission. Students must attend all classes from the commencement of the academic session. In case absence is due to illness, the student must submit an application signed by the parent / guardian along with a certificate from a registered Medical Practitioner.

The College encourages students to pursue various Professional Courses / Jobs along with their regular classes provided such courses / jobs do not interfere with their College class timings.

UNIFORM: Students are expected to be decently dressed on all College Days. The College has a 'Uniform' for formal occasions only. All students must order this prescribed uniform in the College at the time of admission and collect it on time. The College will not be responsible if the students fail to collect their uniforms. (In case of any problem pertaining to it the student must meet the Principal). Students participating in sports or representing the College in the Inter-Collegiate, Inter-State or other sports activities, must wear the prescribed Sports Uniform,

It is compulsory to wear the College Uniform on all formal occasions and Semester Examinations.





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Campus Cleanliness: Students must keep the campus clean. The College has a lush green garden with various plants and trees. It is mandatory for the students to help in keeping their surroundings clean and green.

The College has designated canteen area, with ample seating place. **The students should not eat in the classrooms.**

NB: Disciplinary action will be taken against students found indulging in littering the campus and classrooms.

PARKING OF VEHICLES:

The College maintains a parking system for students desirous of using it for their two wheelers. Vehicles MUST NOT be parked at the College entrance or in the drive way. Special provisions are made for differently abled students.

Annual parking fee ₹800/- (Rupees Eight Hundred only) (to be paid once only) is charged for two wheelers only. The student must collect the receipt and Parking Card from the College Office. This card must be shown whenever asked by the concerned authority.

NB: Wearing helmet is compulsory, failing which a fine of ₹500/- (Rupees Five Hundred) shall be imposed.

DOCUMENTS & CARDS:

Every student of the College must have an Identity Card and a Parking Card (For students coming by two wheelers), issued by the College. She must always wear the Identity Card on person while on campus. These cards must be complete in all respects and the fee column must have the entry by the authorized Office Staff. Students carrying Identity Cards showing blank or incomplete fee-columns will not be allowed to appear in the Semester Examinations. The students must, therefore, ensure that their parking cards are updated on time. Students are not allowed entry into the accounts' offices. All work pertaining to official matters is to be done through the Coordinator or at the designated counter. Disobedience in this regard is treated as gross indiscipline. Tampering with one's identity card or forging of signatures is a serious offence, liable to strict disciplinary action. These cards must be produced at the time of the Semester Examinations by every candidate.

All the students are advised to collect a receipt against any payment made by them in the College at any time.

NOTICES:

Students must read regularly all the notice updates on the notice-boards of the College and on the College Website: 'www.agdc.ac.in' and 'official facebook page'. The College will not accept any responsibility for any loss or damage incurred by a student owing to her failure to read the notices in time either in the College or on the College website.

ALL STUDENTS MUST

- a) Deposit fees and collect their receipts on time. **Fee Receipts are important.**
- b) Collect their Identity Cards within the notified period to avoid fine / penalty.

FINES AND PENALTIES: The students are liable to be fined in case of:

- 1) Loss of Fee Receipts, Identity-Cards and Parking Cards: ₹100/- (**Rupees Hundred only**).
- 2) Semester Examination Form (Late Fees as per the University of Lucknow).

Students found indulging in indiscipline, violating College RULES or resorting to unfair means in the Semester Examinations will be liable to strict disciplinary action. The students are required to show due regard for the rights and property of the College. Any student found guilty of tampering or damaging the property, fixtures, equipment, furniture, books, building, vehicles etc. of the College will be punished and be liable for expulsion from the College.

A student is required to make a declaration to the effect that she will submit to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the College and will observe and abide by the rules made by the College. **In matters of interpretation of the rules and the jurisdiction of the authorities of the College** the student will have to accept the decision of the **Principal as final and binding**.

RAGGING: Ragging in any form is totally banned in the College. The College has an Anti-Ragging Cell. Any student found guilty of indulging in ragging of any kind will be expelled from the College and subject to action as per Government directives.

The College maintains a **Mentor Mentee System** under which each student is allotted a Faculty Mentor to resolve any problem of the students. Students having any problems, queries or requiring assistance must approach these Mentors or Deans for help or guidance. Students still not satisfied with the Redressal may then approach the Principal on stipulated days and time. They will have to seek prior appointment from the Principal's Office to avoid any inconvenience in case their parents / guardian wish to meet the Principal.

COURSES OF STUDY

The students are prepared for the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.), Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com) and Master's Degree in English, Education, Geography and Political Science, Affiliated to University of Lucknow.

The course is as per the N.E.P. 2020 Guidelines of the University of Lucknow.

B.A. (BACHELOR OF ARTS): B.A. (NEP) Three Year Programme is as per the N.E.P. 2020 Guidelines of the University of Lucknow. In the session 2025-2026, the student will choose two major subjects (Major 1 & Major 2) and one Minor subject from the ten subjects available in the College, from the permitted combinations of subjects for B.A. – Semester – I students. Each student is responsible for the subject combination chosen by her endorsed by the Admission Committee. Each student will have to take her University Examination in the subjects finally allotted to her.

B.COM. (BACHELOR OF COMMERCE): The B.Com. NEP 2020, a three year program is designed to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of commerce and business principles. The course consists of different subjects in six semester and covers topic related to commerce, finance, and business.

LIBRARY

The College has a well-equipped Digitalised Library to promote Scholarship and learning amongst its students. The Library offers the facility of INFLIBNET and DELNET to the Faculty and students, which gives access to more than 92,27,613 books; 33,916 periodicals; 9,12,342 Periodicals Articles; 19,234 CD ROM; 5000 Video Recordings; 48,621 Dissertations; 1,631 e-books, besides providing infrastructure for sharing of Library resources among Academic and Research Institutes of world Repute.

The Library has an open-shelf system.

A Library Orientation Programme is organized for the First Year students at the beginning of each new session in which they are acquainted with the Catalogue System, the Reference Books Section, the Book-Bank and the System of Issuing and Returning of Books. The students are required to use the Catalogue System to locating and issuing the requisite books. Students must carry their identity card and library card for issuing of books. Books are issued for only six days at a time. A fine of ₹5/- per day is charged on books overdue. All books and magazines must be handled with care. If a book is subjected to any damage or pages are found missing, the borrower will be held responsible and will have to replace the book. The students are, therefore, advised to check the books before borrowing them and if they discover any kind of damage, it must be immediately reported to the Librarian. If a book is lost, the borrower will have to replace it with the same edition / revised edition / or pay the current price of the Book.

Book Bank: The College Library maintains a Book Bank and deserving students may borrow books from it through membership. Priority for membership will be given to students of Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes, S.T. and Minorities and those who parents' income is not more than ₹1.5 Lakh per year.

- (1) Student eligible for membership to the Book Bank is required to submit an application in duplicate with the necessary documents at the time of admission.
- (2) Each member of the Book Bank is entitled to borrow six books at a time.
- (3) Books can be issued for the full academic session.
- (4) Security deposit of ₹110/- and 10% of the price of the book will be taken at the time of issuing of books which shall be refunded on return of books in good condition.
 - a) If a book is subject to any damage or if any pages are found missing, the borrower will be held responsible and will have to replace the book. The students are advised to check the books before borrowing them and if they discover any kind of damage, it must immediately be reported to the Librarian. If a book is lost, the borrower will have to replace it with the same edition/ revised edition / pay a fine which three times the cost of the book.
 - b) It is at the discretion of the Librarian / Principal to take action against the student for misusing the Library or breaking the rules.

Note: Any change in the rules will be notified.





COMPUTER LAB

The College has a fully equipped, air-conditioned Computer Lab with power back-up consisting of 32 computers with Intel®Core™ i5-6500 CPU @ 3.20 Ghz processor, 4GB RAM 64 bit Windows 10 Home Single Language.

The Lab is Wi-Fi enabled with 300 MBPS fibreband connections. The Lab regularly updates the hardware, software and networking as per requirements. Students can get hands-on experience on latest software applications and browse permitted internet sites for academic purposes.

The College also gives an opportunity to the students to avail Certificate course. The Certificate course includes: Fundamental Training in Computers (Training for preparing brochures, flyers, tabular templates, pamphlets in Word and PowerPoint, Advanced formula for easy calculations in Excel, etc.) MS – Office curriculum: MS –Word, MS-Excel, MS-PowerPoint with shortcut keys.

Interested students may register their names in the Computer Lab. After successful completion of course, Theory and Practical Examination is conducted and Certificates with grade will be issued. The duration of the course is six months.

ADOBE PHOTOSHOP

Certificate in Graphic Designing Course:

The Certificate in Graphic Design is structured to provide knowledge and skills through intensive sessions on subjects that cover a wide spectrum of the multiple media. Adobe Photoshop is one of the Media course. The modules of the course are Multimedia, Fundamentals and image Editing Techniques. In this course students are learning the use of illustrators and layouts, editing images, bring effects on the images addressing the design theory topics like colour, typography, layers and composition. Practical sessions include the hands-on photo editing, logo design, poster design, fabric design, magazine covers and layouts.

ANNUAL AWARDS

Certificates of Distinction:

Certificates of Distinction (75% and above) are awarded to students securing distinction marks in any subject in B.A., B.Com., and M.A. Semester Examinations of University of Lucknow.

Awards for High Attendance:

Medals for highest attendance are awarded to those students of B.A., B.Com., and M.A. who have the highest percentage of attendance (90% or above for each subject during each Semester).
